
Applying his education and faith as a priest in the San Francisco Archdiocese, he taught and enriched the lives of others, a purpose he pursued throughout his life.




Receiving dispensation from the priesthood, he fulfilled a lifelong dream by finding his love, Evelyn, and starting a family.
